Rehearsals and Expectations

- You are expected to be available for all rehearsals.
- You are only allowed to miss 3 rehearsals, without losing your role.
- Detailed rehearsal schedules will be updated daily and will be posted on the Richland Performing Arts Center's website.
- You should arrive at rehearsal 15 minutes early. If you are early you are on time, if you are on time you are late!
- You should wear appropriate rehearsal clothing.
- You should bring your script, 2 pencils, and water bottle. You should bring homework and snacks for long rehearsals.
- Please leave all belongs in grand hall, before entering the theatre.
- You are required to stay in the assigned rehearsal halls at all-time unless directed otherwise.
- Once you arrive at rehearsal you are not allowed to leave the rehearsal at any time; until dismissal of a scheduled rehearsal of performance by one of the directors.
- Remember all rehearsals are closed doors to everyone except the cast and crew.

Absenteeism

- There should be no unauthorized absences at all.
- You are responsible for logging on to the website and submitting an excuse online to why you cannot attend a rehearsal.

Planned Absences:

- You should check the rehearsal schedule immediately and notify the staff immediately on our website, if you can foresee a clash of dates.

Unplanned Absences:

- If you are sick on the day of rehearsal you are to contact us by phone (814-269-0300 Option 3) or use the online absentee system. Sending a message with another student will be considered 'unauthorized'.
- Any unauthorized absences may jeopardize your role.

Tardy / Late to School:

- If you are late to school and are tardy for any reason (Excused of Unexcused) school policy will prevail in your participation. Please see your student handbook for more information.
